# IMPORTANT Notices

#### **AGE VERIFICATION FORMS**

A completed Age Verification Form, along with a proof of age document (driver's license, birth certificate, passport, State I.D. etc.) is required by the State of California for every Resident living in a Senior Designated community. Many Residents still have not turned in a completed Form with proof of age document. Our Association must report to the State of California very soon – so this article is a reminder if you have not provided your Form with proof of age –

PLEASE DO IT WITHIN THE NEXT 10 DAYS.

# PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE AS REQUIRED BY THE CC&R'S.

All owners of units in the New Horizons Community, are required by the CC&R's to carry liability insurance. We need to verify that you have insurance. Please call your insurance company and add New Horizons South Bay Association as an "additional interest" on your insurance policy.

This is for NOTIFICATION PURPOSES ONLY – you are not insuring the Association. Your insurance company will automatically notify the "additional interest" (which is our Association) if there is any lapse, renewal or cancellation of your policy. If an owner does not wish to carry liability insurance, then that owner may place on deposit with the Association, the amount of the current insurance deductible per unit owned. These funds will be refunded to the owner when proof of liability insurance is provided.

For owners who have not yet provided their insurance information – you are not in compliance with the CC&R's,

### **HH Waste/E-Waste Roundup**

The Conservation Club will hold our Annual Household Hazardous Waste & Electronics Waste Roundup to assist residents safely and properly dispose of these dangerous products. HHW is any product labeled toxic, poison, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant. E-waste is electronic equipment and accessory (any item with a plug). They contain a number of toxic components.

Please follow these safety guidelines before bringing items to the roundup:

- Package all HHW items carefully
- Tightly cap or tape down all items
- Place small liquid containers inside baggies
- Remove or black out personal information from original medicine container

Paint is no longer accepted.



## **CLARIFICATION?**

Our last Newsletter stated: "CLUB HOUSE: At the next Workshop (June 13<sup>th</sup>) we will be discussing whether or not to keep the balconies. Again, design, cost and impact on the budget. Bids are currently being collected."

This project is referring to the Club House remodel only. The balconies on the Club House are currently in disrepair. The roof will be scheduled for replacement soon.

During the last Board Meeting, the pending legislation SB 721 concerning our balconies and decks was discussed in light of the proposed law which will mandate inspections and repair requirements by licensed contractors. The following information was brought up at the meeting.

- "1. The proposed law carries serious and timely inspection requirements and the burden on inspectors to discover whatever needs to be done and the liability risk if they fail and is considerable. For that reason, the necessary inspectors may not be available in abundance.
- 2. And getting necessary work accomplished within the very limited timeline in the statute, six months, may not be seamless. Because of fires and floods in California within the last year, resources in the form of workers and contractors tend en masse to congregate where the most work is needed."

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
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
