The NH Conservation Club will hold our Annual HHW/E-Waste Roundup to assist NH residents dispose of household hazardous and electronic waste safely and properly. HWW is any product labeled **toxic**, **poison**, **corrosive**, **flammable**, **combustible**, **or irritant**. Electronic equipment and accessories are considered hazardous because they contain a number of toxic components including lead, mercury, and other heavy metals.

Please follow these safety guidelines before bringing items to Access 1:

- Package all HHW items carefully
- Tightly cap or tape down all items
- Place small containers with liquid inside into baggies
- Remove or black out personal information from original medicine container
- Package florescent bulbs to avoid breakage

A list of collectable items is posted on the bulletin board in the Club House.


