### Picnic Fun Club - Labor Day Picnic



The Board reviewed the action tracker, sent to the board for review each week, with pending projects. A special *Thank You* was given to the Conservation Club for donating the new Sports Center Windows.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- Civic Affairs Committee: Julie Dojiri gave her report and announced important dates/events occurring within the community and the City of Torrance.
- Go Green Committee: Barbara Marriott gave her report and requested to have all firestick plants removed by Monarch at

no additional cost, due to their being poisonous and a potential risk to staff. Peter Wu seconded the motion. (M/S/C: 6-0)

• Picnic Fun Club: Barbara Kerr reminded the community about the Labor Day Picnic.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSSINESS**

**Expansion of walkway proposals:** The Board reviewed a proposal to repair several tripping hazards in front of Building 125. This proposal was tabled for the September meeting. Tom requested to confirm with Finley's that they add areas in front of the Clubhouse.

#### NEW BUSINESS

**Olive Trees:** The board reviewed the proposals submitted by Finley's to trim, treat and remove olive trees throughout the property.

• Pickle Ball: The board reviewed a request read from homeowners Joe and Maureen Morton to consider adding a pickle ball court to the tennis court. A net and striping tape would have to be purchased. After long discussion, Mary Carruthers spoke on behalf of the tennis players club against the addition of the pickle ball court. The board decided to table the subject until doing more research and gathering homeowner input on the subject.

**Bait Stations Proposal:** Janet Garcia presented a proposal to increase the amount of bait stations. This proposal was tabled until we obtain the exact amount and locations of the current baits on the property.
