Yesterday, my wife and I, joined by several members of the club who were disappointed in not going as a group, made an excursion on our own to see this wonderful exhibition. The exhibition features a thoroughly captivating glimpse into the opulent lifestyle and tragic end of this ancient Roman society forgotten for centuries until its rediscovery over 250 years ago.
